Old Business

Speelhoffer Park

Mrs. Tackett stated she still needs to provide the Parks Board with a breakdown of the remaining funds from the grant that could be applied to a shade structure. The request for reimbursement for the fencing still needs to be submitted to the State.

Wayland Park- Eagle Scout Project

It was discussed that there should be a meeting with the Eagle Scouts, township staff and members of the Parks Board at the park to walk the trail planned for being marked. It was noted that the trail will likely need to be cleared and the Boy Scouts may be willing to help with that.

New Business

Community Day

Plans for the 2023 Community Day event began to be discussed as follows:

- The hours would remain 10-3
- No charge for the kid activities
- Include the shred event
- Check with the Fire Company regarding doing the parking and having them keep the donations for parking. This would free up volunteers for other tasks.
- Mochias is willing to do the food again this year, but the beer garden will not occur due to the high cost associated with it.

- Staff will begin the process of securing the main vendors and will reach out to potential sponsors, community agencies, and vendors for the farmers/craft area in April.
- An article about Community Day will be included in the spring newsletter.

Grant Funding for Playground
